

English Communications: Final Presentations

For this presentation you will work with a partner to tell the class about an inspiring person. The topic (inspiring person) you choose must be approved by the instructor.

What do you need to do?

1. Find a partner
2. Choose an inspiring person
3. Tell the instructor your topic
4. Give a 10 minute presentation.
 - You must prepare a PowerPoint presentation
 - You do not need to memorize your presentation, but you shouldn't just read off a paper.
 - Each partner must speak for an equal amount of time.
 - You can include a YouTube video in your presentation but it must be in English and it cannot be longer than 3 minutes.
5. Presentations will be given on December 31st and January 7th

Presentation Format

Introduction

-You should begin your presentation in an interesting way to catch the audience's attention

Body of Presentation

-Explain your inspiring person

-Tell the class the 'who, what, when, where, why' about your inspiring person

(Example: **Who** is your story about? **What** did they do that inspired you? **When** did they do this action? **Where** did they do this action? **Why** did they do this action?)

Conclusion

-You should end your presentation with a brief summary and a strong concluding statement.

-Do not say "Thank you for your listening"!
