Vocabulary and Phrases:

1. **Titanium:** a chemical element, with the symbol Ti and atomic number 22, also a strong metal.
2. **Ricochet:** If a bullet ricochets, it hits a surface such as a wall and bounces away from it again at an angle.
3. **Bulletproof:** Something that is bulletproof can stop bullets passing through it.
4. **Fire away (at someone):** to ask many questions of someone; to criticize someone severely.
5. **Aim:** to point the weapon or object in your direction.
6. **Cut someone down:** to let go; abandon someone; to make someone feel desperate.
7. **Haunted:** A place where ghosts regularly appear; a person frightened by ghosts.
8. **Raise someone's voice:** begin to speak more loudly, usually you're becoming angry.
9. **Sticks and stones may break my bones (but words will never hurt me):** Idioms, people cannot hurt you with bad things they say or write about you.
10. **Stone-hard:** hard like a stone.
