

# Oral English Midterm Presentation

---

For this presentation you will do a voice-over (say the words/sounds) for a movie trailer with a partner.

## What do you have to do?

- Find a partner
- Choose a movie trailer (no R-rated movies will be accepted)
- Tell the teacher the trailer you chose (you must get approval from the teacher)
- Type out the transcript for the trailer (transcript = words/script)
- Practice the voice-over for the trailer (this includes speaking and sound effects)
- Practice, practice, practice!
- You should memorize the words for the voice-over
- Do the voice-over for your trailer in class (play the video on mute and do the voice-over)

## Trailer Rules

1. The trailer must be an official trailer (not just one made by someone online).
2. The trailer must be between 2-4 minutes in length.
3. You must download the video to show in class; you may not livestream from the Internet.
4. Your downloaded file must be played in Windows Media Player – so make sure it works before class!

## Transcript Rules

1. The transcript must be accurate – correct words, grammar, and spelling.
2. You must understand the meaning of transcript – if there is a confusing phrase I may ask you to explain the meaning, so be prepared to answer.
3. If you need help understanding your transcript you can come see me during my office hours, or make an appointment at the writing clinic.
4. **Do not come and see me and ask me to help you write the transcript without writing out a full draft by yourself first.**
5. **Do not email me your transcript to edit for you. Come and see me to ask a specific question about a part you don't understand.**

## Marking

Presentation – 50%

\*You just need to hand in one copy of the transcript per group.

\*You must give me a copy of your transcript **before** you present in class.

\*You will get a group grade for your transcript and an individual grade for your presentation.
